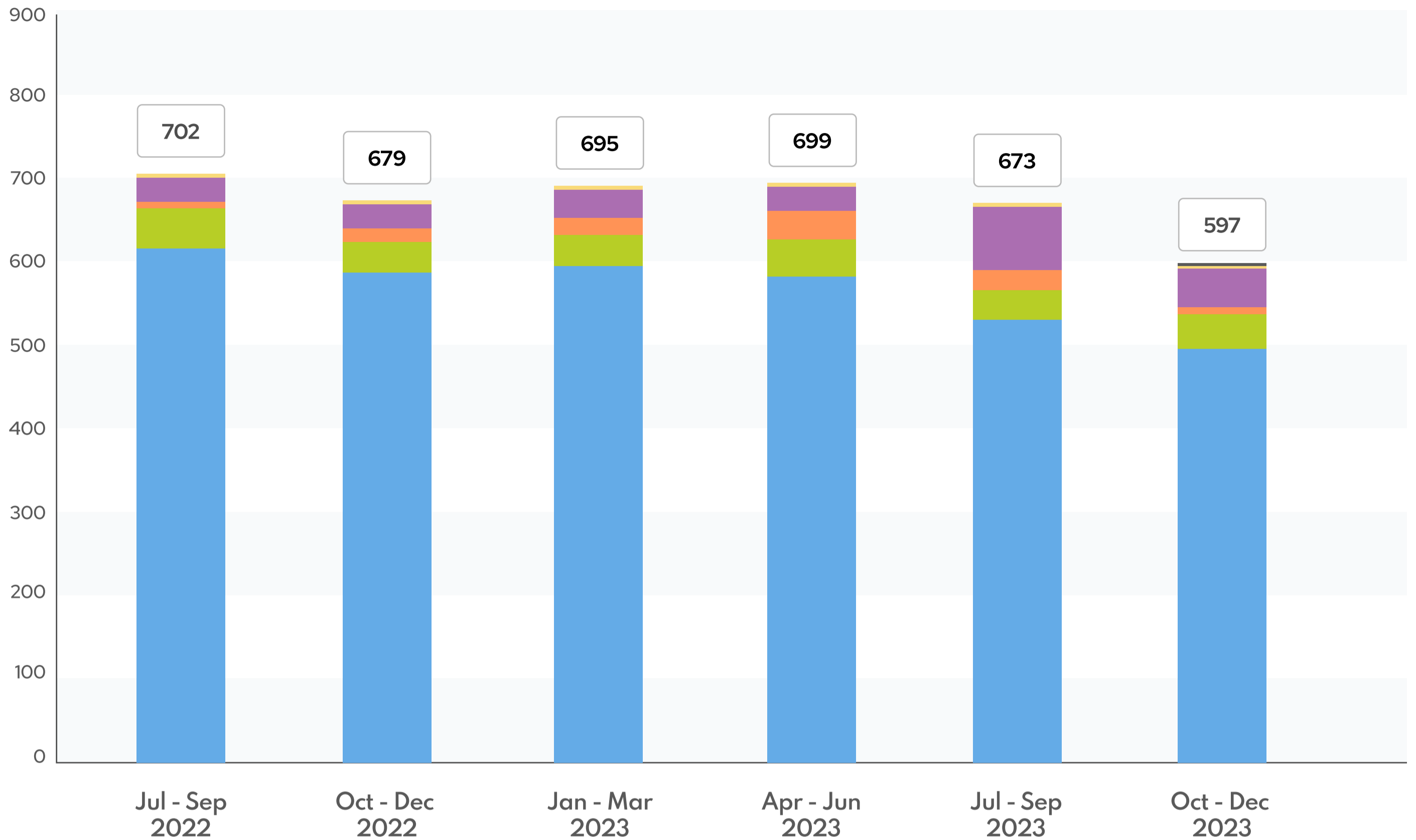


FIST Program Outcomes*

Notes:

Enrolled in FIST Program Slots: Clients that are currently served with housing and other services in the FIST program.

Lost to Follow-Up: Clients who left the program with unknown outcome.

Transitioned to Non-ODR Permanent Supportive Housing: Clients who are discharged from the program to a non-ODR permanent housing – family, independent living, other permanent housing program.

Transitioned to ODR Permanent Housing Program: Clients who are discharged from the program and transitioned into an ODR permanent housing program.

Reincarcerated: Clients who are remanded from court, violated probation/court order, or charged with a new crime.

*Based on latest documented scenario during the quarter. Data represent ODR participant’s housing status during the reporting quarter.
